Kerry Shawn Keys' roots are in the Appalachian Mountains. From 1998 to 2000, he taught translation theory and creative composition as a Fulbright Associate Professor at Vilnius University. His work ranges from theatre-dance pieces to flamenco songs to meditations on the Tao Te Ching, and is often lyrical with intense ontological concerns. Of late, he has been writing prose *wonderscripts*, and plays. His most recent book is *Night Flight* (poems), 2012. Keys received the Robert H. Winner Memorial Award from the Poetry Society of America in 1992, and in 2005 a National Endowment for the Arts Literature Fellowship.

David Hernandez is the recipient of a 2011 NEA Literature Fellowship in Poetry. His recent collection, *Hoodwinked*, won the Kathryn A. Morton Prize and is now available from Sarabande Books. His other collections include *Always Danger* (SIU Press, 2006), winner of the Crab Orchard Series in Poetry, and *A House Waiting for Music* (Tupelo Press, 2003). His poems have appeared in *FIELD*, *Ploughshares*, *The Threepenny Review*, *The Missouri Review*, *TriQuarterly*, *The Southern Review*, and *Poetry Daily*. He is also the author of two YA novels, *No More Us for You* and *Sucker-punch*, both published by HarperCollins.
